# IMO SKYWARN

- Organization of Amateur Radio operators
- Facilitates relay of reports from hams to NWS
- Staffs amateur station at NWS: WX9IWX
- Four quadrants & quadrant leaders
- WX9IWX monitors 1 repeater in each quadrant



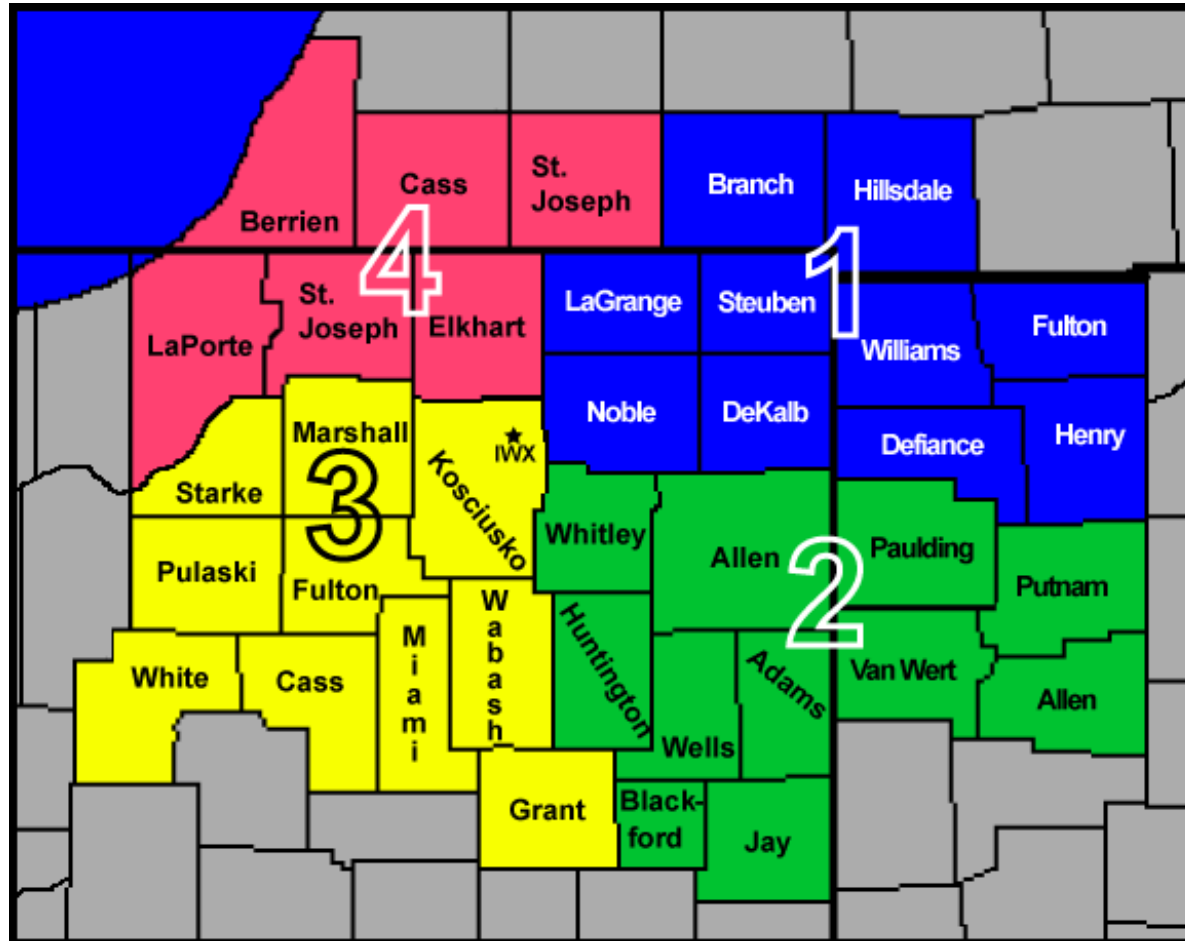

# Standby Mode

- ❑ Alerts users severe weather possible
- ❑ Prepares repeater to receive reports
- ❑ Repeater announces “weather watch”
- ❑ Reset tone “W”
- ❑ Normal use with gaps (chat about anything you want)
- ❑ Net control operator monitors
- ❑ To call: “SKYWARN this is (call sign).”



# Directed Net

- ❑ When required by report volume
- ❑ Not needed for all warnings
- ❑ Net control uses own call sign (formerly W9INX)
- ❑ Repeater announces “weather net,” reset tone becomes “N”
- ❑ Check-in only with criteria-meeting reports, emergency traffic
- ❑ Check-in with your call sign (phonetically), one or two-word report summary



# Check-In/Report Example

- Spotter: “Whiskey nine alpha bravo charlie, wind damage”
- NCS: “ABC stand by”
- NCS: “IWX?”
- WX9IWX: “IWX”
- NCS: “Standby for a wind damage report. ABC, go ahead.”
- Spotter: “Whiskey nine alpha bravo charlie observed shingles blowing from a roof at one six three zero local time in Fort Wayne near the intersection of State Boulevard and Hobson Road.”
- WX9IWX: “Roger, WX9IWX.”
- NCS: “W9GGA, SKYWARN net control.”



# Check-In/Report Example (No IWX)

- Spotter: “Whiskey nine alpha bravo charlie, wall cloud”
- NCS: “ABC stand by”
- NCS: “IWX?”
- (No response from IWX)
- NCS: “ABC, go ahead.” (NCS takes report)
- Spotter: “Whiskey nine alpha bravo charlie observed a wall cloud at one six three zero local time in Fort Wayne near the intersection of State Boulevard and Hobson Road.”
- NCS: “Roger, ABC. W9GGA, SKYWARN net control.”





# Report Criteria

- Tornado
- Funnel cloud
- Wall cloud
- Hail of any size
- Wind damage (regardless of wind speed) or measured wind at least 50 MPH (damage expected)
- Storm-related injury or death
- Flooding
