The following guidelines are requested by the Northern Indiana NWS Office

- 1) All operators should register in advance to receive a scheduled operating period. This allows the NWS office to know who and when each visitor is expected to be on site. (registration contact given below)
- 2) All visitors will be required to sign in upon arrival and sign out at departure. If you have a ham radio name badge, please wear it while in the building.
- 3) The NWS office is an operational government facility. The Skywarn Recognition Day event is not an open house and tours will not be supported. Volunteers are expected to confine operation to the designated radio station room and break areas.
- 4) As visitors at the NWS office, all operators are expected to observe common courtesy etiquette and maintain cleanliness. Snacks are welcome, but what you carry in, you must carry out. The restrooms are gender specific; please use only the appropriate facility.
- 5) Coffee will be available at the NWS office, but other snacks or non-alcoholic beverages are the responsibility of the special event operators at their discretion.
