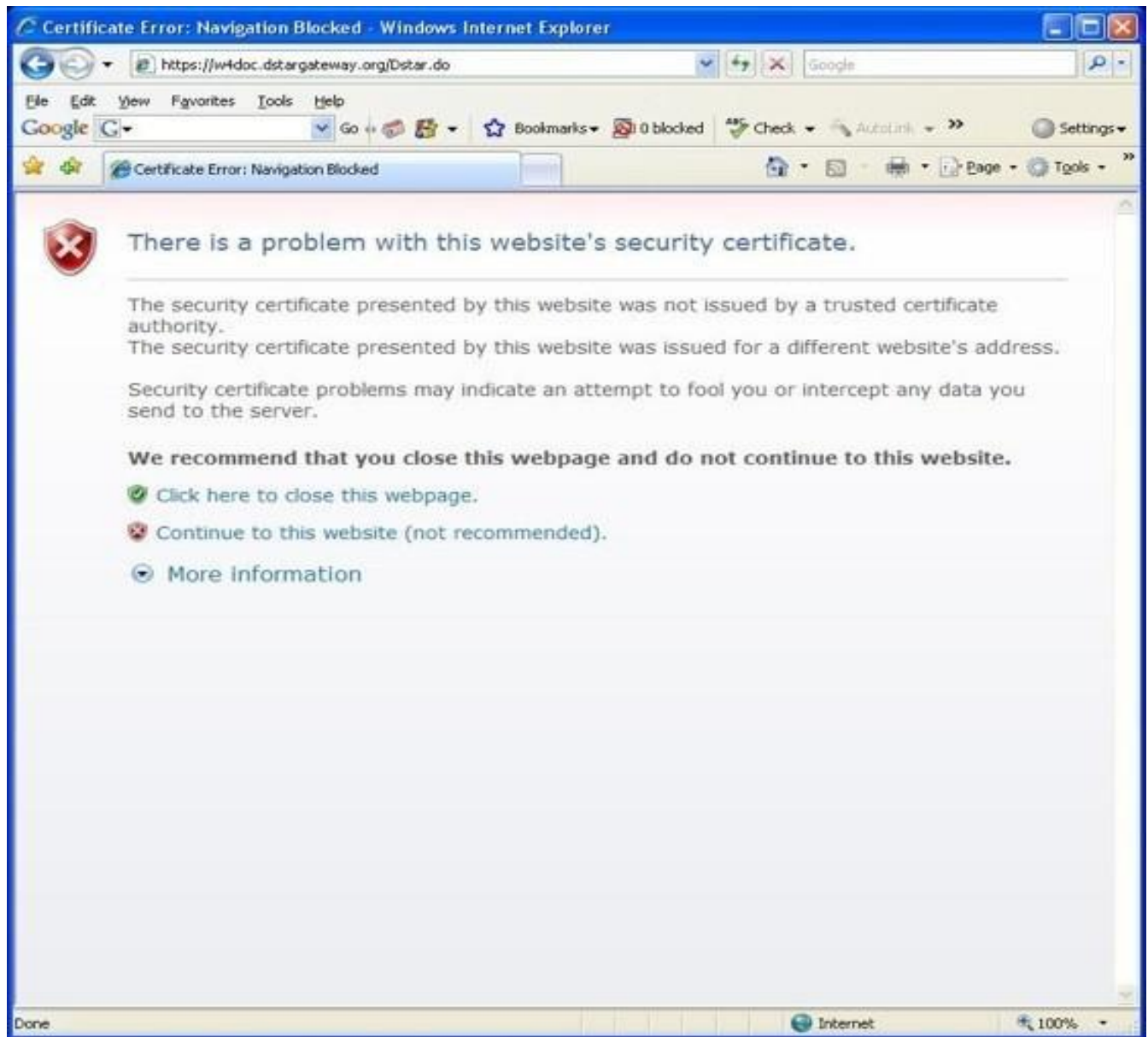
D-Star Self Registration Instructions

1) Open a web browser and enter

<https://184.17.140.214:4243/Dstar.do>

Notice that you are using https and not http for the prefix and that the letter “D” is capitalized in the word “Dstar.do”.

To register your call sign with the D-Star network, please follow the steps listed below. Should you have any problems with registration, send email to phixer@gmail.com and include your name, call sign, and problem description.



2) You will receive a warning similar to the one above. Select “Continue to this website” if using Internet Explorer, or “Accept this certificate temporarily for this session” if using Firefox, or “Continue” if using Apple Safari.

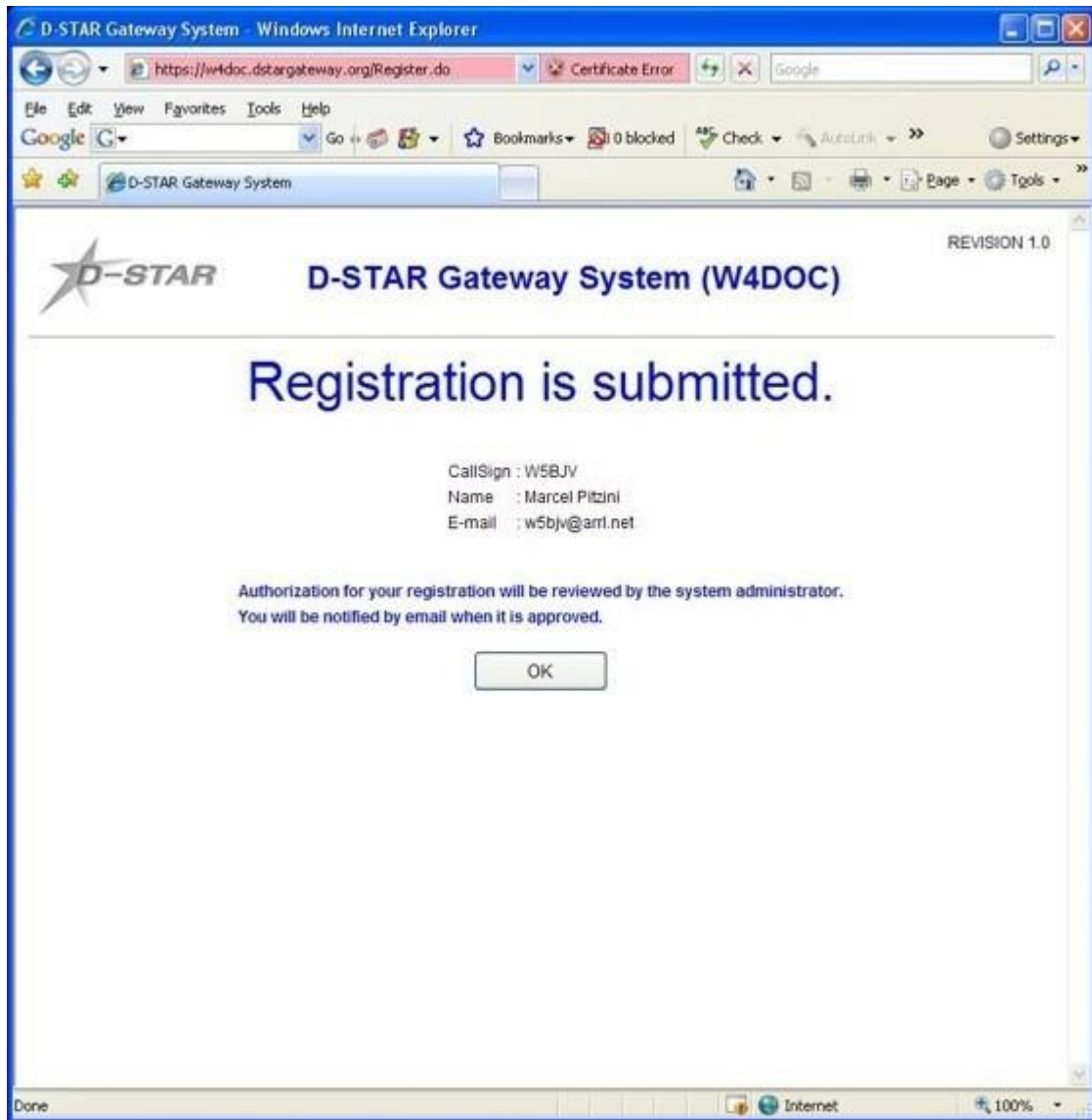

9) Click on the checkbox next to the number “1”. Then click inside the “Initial” box to the right of your call sign on the same line as the number “1”. Type in a *single space character*. This will not show up but is very important. Do not click on the “RPT” check box. In the “pname” box, enter your call sign in *lower case* All characters in the “pname” box should be lower case and there should be no spaces. Your web page should look similar to the following page (with your personal information shown). When complete, click on “Update”.

10) Once you have clicked “Update”, you should see the following popup box.



11) Click “OK” and your registration is COMPLETE! **You may log out and begin using the D-Star network!**
