Programing Your Radio for D-Star Voice

Here is a table summarizing the setups for the various Linking and Gateway usage.

The first row demonstrates calling "CQ" on simplex, on 70cm.

The second demonstrates calling "CQ" on the local repeater ports of the W9TE system.

The third demonstrates calling a specific station, KC9MUT, using the gateway.

The forth shows how to call "CQ" through the gateway when there is a reflector connected.

The last shows how to call "CQ" through the gateway to a remote system 2 meter port, in this case W9ICE. In each case you are transmitting on 70cm. (note that there is a slash '/' right in front of W9ICE's callsign)

Remember: Call sign fields have eight positions for characters, and the last one is where the 'port switch' needs to be. Adjust spaces accordingly, or be frustrated!

NOTE: Always replace the "KA30PZ" call sign in the MyCALL field examples above with your own station call sign
